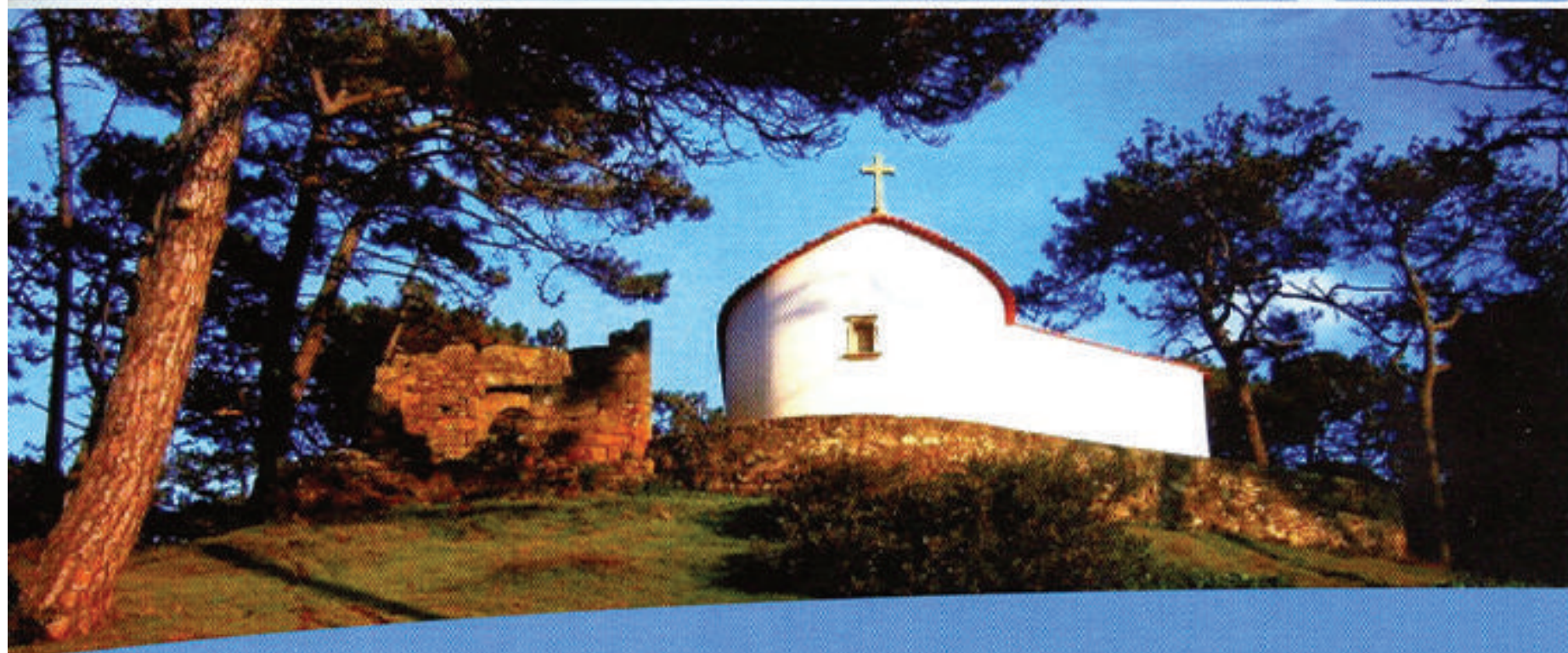

PEDESTRIAN ROUTE
MEMORY FOOTPATH

The Pedestrian Route Network, which running through the town of Fão, a former salt center in the middle ages, with its historic area as the highlight and the natural scenery along the estuary of the river Cávado and the Atlantic ocean beaches.

Individuals should follow the locational signs on the ground and in front of the passage and circulating areas. One has as a starting point the promenade of Bom Jesus, where the temple of Bom Jesus de Fão is situated.

Then follow the left bank of the river Cávado, passing near the D. Luis Filipe bridge, an excellent sample of iron architecture, then through the inner side a stretch of the route along the river marsh and dunes, filled with natural wonders that make this a very sensitive area from an environmental point of view.

Subsequently the cosmopolitan beach of Ofir, the Chapel and Torch of Bonança, the Barreiras Medieval Cemetery, one of the most significant monuments of its kind in the whole Iberian Peninsula, leading the way to the old core of fangueira village. It is an eclectic route, with diverse landscapes, full of monumental and natural wonders, an integrating part of its trek in the North Coast Natural Park area.
